#### The Upper House Yorkies defeat the Lion Westbury A as we have the big shock result of the round!

The defending Champions rarely needed their +2 start from last year but the -3 afforded to Upper House Yorkies this year would prove to be a real test.

Roger Jones profited from Rod Edwards in-off on the black and Yorkies were 4-0 up after the first frame. Steve Richards & Macca McVean reduced it to 4-2 but when Paul Yorkie McGrath won the 4th frame, the home side were on the brink of victory at 5-2.

Barry Emberton 1/1 & Steve Richards 2/2 battled back to 4-5 but when Macca went in off in frame 7 Jamie "Joshua" Pugh cleared up with style to end the Lion's reign!

The **Punchbowl** complete 3 excellent days with a win against the **Horseshoe Inn** (see Hughie Lewis also). Following up from their 6-4 success in the prelim over Welly Dukes on Monday night, they recovered from R C Edwards 1st frame win to lead 3-1. Ricky Lowe, Jim Knight with a **7-baller** over J Bebb and John Morris were all on target before R C Edwards made it 3-2 at the half. When John Morris went to 2/2 the away side took note and replied through J Davies and R L Edwards 2/2 and the match was alive at 4-4.

Ricky Lowe & Jim Knight both went to 2/2 however to take the match and avoid the nervy deciding game draw. Talking of nervous deciding frames, the **Four Crosses A** had a top result as they defeat **Cock A** 6-5 in Forden! Gary Gindrat & Pete Sheppard found their team 3-2 down despite their best efforts, as Rob Owen, Roger Russell and Garry Lewis forged a lead. Gary Gindrat 2/2 and Darren Bowen made it a better score for the Cock but when Gwyn Hughes 1/1 and Roger Russell 2/2 both won it was 5-4 Crosses.

Paul Morris took the 10th frame and a draw was made, where Darren and Gwyn came "out of the hat" to battle. Gwyn's superbly disguised treble on the black took the match and then the face book banter started...

The **Angel A** set about their -2 disadvantage against the **Breidden** with aplomb, as Kev Morris, Alun Evans, Justin Williams and Digger took 4 frames from the off.

M Fellows effectively reduced the gap to 3-4 but Kev Morris 2/2 showed what an asset he's become for the home team this season and made it 5-3. The Breidden have produced some very good results in this format however, and it may not have been such a surprise to see M Fellow 2/2 and P Kelly 1/1 forced another drawn decider!

Cougan Jones got the better of R Hilditch to finally win the game, as a

sporting Breidden put "good game, right result in the end" on the back of the card. Although I haven't received the card yet, well done to a resilient **Courthouse** who won the last 5 frames of the match including the all important decider, against a strong Argae B team who couldn't cross the line on the night!

The **Oak A** recorded a comfortable looking 6-2 win over their **Oak B** counterparts after a Dai Walsh break and dish **7-baller** start over Keith Harding. It could have been a different story if Dave Gannon & Glyn Davies had seen chances taken against them but the B side had only Spencer Lewis win before Dave Roach made it 4-1 at the break. Kevin Davies 1/1 made it 2-4 but Dai Walsh & Dave Gannon both 2/2 sealed the win to go through to the last 8 of this competition.

**Castle Boys** travelled to **Four Crosses B** and over came a 2 frame disadvantage to win 6-5! Brian Davies and Kelly Brooks wiped out the handicap difference but Jordan Smedley was on target for the Crosses to make it 3-2. Richard Wyatt levelled the match but the home side made a big move to win the tie, as Rich Huxley 1/1 and James Lewis both won and the home side led 5-3. The Boys hung tough however and thanks to Kelly and Rich (both 2/2) the game went in to overtime, where Steve Day took the plaudits with the winning frame over Jordan Smedley.

Finally, the **Nomads** over come a tricky -3 start at home to a good **Herbert Arms** side. The home side never allowed the away team to get settled however, as Steve Sherlock, Dean Arthur, Jason Stokes, Steve Jones and Andy Francis made it a clean sweep of the first half! Phil Davies finally registered for the Arms, but any hopes of a deciding game disappeared as Nomads skipper Steve 2/2 completed a very good home win.
