RULE CHECK!

In a recent doubles game I was asked if an in-off from the break allowed the choice of a re-rack? The answer is NO. This is a foul of the break, not an illegal break; a free shot and 2nd visit results in this situation, with the white placed anywhere behind the baulk line.

An illegal break is where a ball is not potted, or two balls do not pass an imaginary line across the middle of the table. In this situation two shots can be played where the white lies (free shot then 2nd visit), or a re-rack called and two shots played as normal.

Please note, if the black is potted on either the break or a re-rack, then it is simply re-racked and the same player breaks again.

And yes, I had to check with the League Secretary and my pc for the rule sheet as it's not immediately obvious to find.
